

Prescription Drug Plan-Summary of Benefits

2010 Enhanced Medicare Part D (ENH-01)

The Sterling Retiree Rx Enhanced Plan ENH 01 will cover 75% of the cost of your prescriptions once you have met your deductible of \$310.

You will be responsible for a \$310 deductible, then a 25% co-insurance up to \$17,270 of the covered Part D drug costs. If you reach \$4,550 out-of-pocket expenses during the year, your co-insurance will be reduced to the greater of 5%, or \$2.50 for generic and multi source drugs, or \$6.30 for all other covered drugs.
