

Prescription Drug Plan-Summary of Benefits
2010 Enhanced Medicare Part D (ENH-02)

The Sterling Retiree Rx Enhanced Plan, ENH 02 will cover 50% of the cost of your prescriptions in the “Coverage Gap.”

You will be responsible for a \$310 deductible, then a 25% co-insurance up to \$2,830 of covered Part D drug costs. Once you have reached \$2,830 in drug costs your co-insurance will be 50% of the drug cost until you reach \$10,050 in drug costs. If you reach \$4,550 out-of-pocket expenses during the year, your co-insurance will be reduced to the greater of 5%, or \$2.50 for generic and multi source drugs, or \$6.30 for all other covered drugs
